This Contribution to the Box to be placed in the Corner Stone of the Public Library, now being Constructed. May tell some future generation something of the origin of the "West Liberty Telephone Exchange".

Early in the year 1900. several of our Citizens discussed the project of a Telephone System. and decided, that if a patronage of Security fees could be assured, they would undertake to Construct one. By a short Campaign this number was pledged. The question of a Franchise was submitted to the Voters, and Carried almost unanimously, and the Town Council granted one. The Company was duly Incorporated under the laws of the State, under the name of the "West Liberty Telephone Exchange".

The Construction was at once Commenced, a Central Office was established in the second story of the J. W. King Building, on the N.E. Corner of Third and Calhoun Streets, and about July 15<sup>th</sup> 1900. The System was so far Completed, that it was opened to the Public,

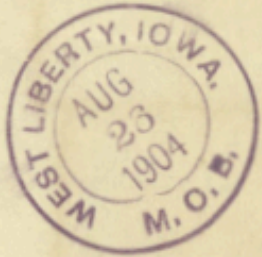
