Indianola, Iowa, December 11, 1905

I will purchase and hang in a proper manner in the lecture room of the Indianola Public Library two colonial wall radiators of nine sections each with a total radiating surface of sixty-three square feet in each radiator; and two colonial wall radiators of six sections each in the south-east room of the basement, each of these radiators having a total radiating surface of forty-two square feet, for Eighty-five Dollars (\$85.00)

These radiators shall be hung between the mains and the walls in their respective places, about six inches from the ceiling; each radiator shall be self draining and provided with one ball cock, and all necessary piping, hangers, etc., for a complete job, the painting to be black or red, as the trustees may decide.

The hangers shall be placed before the plastering is done, the remainder completed after the plastering is on, and completed without damaging or staining the plastering. If such damaging or staining does occur, I will see that it is immediately repaired or properly concealed.

I will wait for warrant or check for said amount till such-a-time-thirty days after the completion of the entire basement.
~~as a check for an additional Two Thousand Dollars above the Ten Thousand already received has arrived at Indianola,--~~

2nd, I will take down the radiators now in place in the basement and rehang them after the plastering is on for \$ Six Dollars, the amount to be received at the same time as the \$85.00 and in addition thereto.

I guarantee the material and work above described, agreeing to remedy any defect that may appear within a year, and remedy it immediately on learning of the fact.
